



Intercultural Fairy Tale Festival 6 - 11 May 2008

Background

This Festival is a journey through fairy tales from Germany, Ireland and the Czech Republic. Through these fairy tales you will discover how other cultures lived, and learn about their language and customs through singing, dancing and theatre. Its main funding comes from the Socrates programme, Lingua, E.U. commission. This is the third festival in the project; the other two took place at Peißnitzhaus in Halle, Germany and at the Theatre Minor in Prague, Czech Republic. We look forward to working with them in this festival.



This week long festival will comprise of workshops for small groups (art, drama, puppetry and music) and a weekend of language learning games, face painting, Irish storytelling, puppetry and music. The highlight will be an interactive intercultural fairy tale play where the audience will be encouraged to participate and perhaps learn a

few words of German, Czech and maybe some new English vocabulary.

The organisers have a long association of working with adults with special needs and the play will showcase the talents of some of the actors from Camphill Community Greenacres as well as actors from Germany & the Czech Republic. Other members of the wider community will be involved in the set design and help out at the information stands.
